Replacing a Fence? Adding a Deck?

If you are making improvements to the outside of your property, then you must fill out an Architectural Committee Improvement Approval Form (available on the website). The purpose of the Architectural Control Committee (ACC) is to protect/enhance homeowner property values. The ACC may reject approval of plans if they do not, in the committee's opinion, conform to the architectural rules as defined by the covenants. Please submit your form early so your project is not delayed.

Reminders
